OMH-HDP Updates	OMH-HDP has provided language access services to all of New York State COVID-19 initiatives and NYS DOH Vaccination sites. These services are provided via in person, virtual relay or telephonic. Currently we have 2 language services providers, each providing services in over 100 languages. The office has provided ASL interpreters via virtual relay and in-person interpreting for vaccination pods. We work with the Nations to ensure support during the pandemic and focus on equitable distribution. We've been working on internal processes and focusing on post pandemic, we will be working on a Health Equity Plan, and also focusing on our legislative charge.
