- ◆ AIDS INSTITUTE Ryan White Part B HIV/AIDS Behavioral Health Education Initiative RFA: The New York State Department of Health AIDS Institute (NYSDOH AI) Division of HIV and Hepatitis Health Care, Bureau of Community Support Services (BCSS) and Health Research, Inc. (HRI) announced the availability of \$2,600,000 in federal Ryan White Part B funds for the provision of HIV/AIDS Behavioral Health Education services to persons living with HIV/AIDS in New York State. The NYSDOH AI continues its commitment to improve and maintain the mental, emotional, and behavioral health of persons living with HIV/AIDS (PLWH/A) in New York State. The HIV/AIDS behavioral health education services to be funded through this Request for Applications (RFA) will support the AIDS Institute's priorities of increasing linkage to and retention in care and treatment as a mechanism to achieving viral suppression among PLWH/A. In addition, funded services will strengthen the comprehensive continuum of HIV prevention, health care, and supportive services in New York State. This will be accomplished by educating clients about the benefits of engaging in mental health and substance abuse treatment, helping to address stigma or related anxiety that may impact a client's willingness to engage in, adhere to, and be retained in their HIV medical and behavioral health care and treatment.
