Individual-level interventions (ILI) provide individualized health communication, health education, and risk reduction counseling to assist clients in creating plans for individual behavior change and making ongoing appraisals of their own behavior. These interventions may consist of one or multiple sessions. Group-level interventions (GLI) may include peer education and support to promote and reinforce safer behaviors. Prevention interventions delivered to groups may be single or multiple sessions, and often provide interpersonal skills training to negotiate and sustain appropriate behavior change. CLIs seek to reduce risk behaviors by changing attitudes, norms, and practices of community members, and may include a combination of intervention types (e.g., outreach, health communication, public information) or units of delivery (e.g., individual, group, community)
