# Knowledge of Undetectable = Untransmittable (U=U) New York State Medical Monitoring Project, 2019

#### Who?

Respondents of the 2019 NYS Medical Monitoring Project. Results include the responses of 82 adults living with HIV in New York State (excludes NYC) as of December 31, 2018.

#### What?

### When asked,

"Have you heard that if you have an undetectable viral load, you will not pass on HIV to sexual partners?"

76% of respondents answered, "Yes"

# Respondent Acceptance of U=U

- 61% believed U=U is at least somewhat true
- 25% did not believe
   U=U is true
- 14% were unsure if U=U is true or false

51% reported seeing media campaigns for U=U

48% had spoken
with their
healthcare provider
about U=U
