SUBJECT: Personal Needs Allowance for Institutionalized Spouses

Receiving Home and Community-Based Waivered Services

Last year the Department changed the personal needs allowance (PNA) for home and community-based waivered recipients who have a community spouse. Instead of the Medicaid income level for one, the PNA was reduced to \$50. Department release 95 ADM-19, issued October 13, 1995, contains language which indicates that the PNA change was required by the Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA). GIS message 94 MA/026, dated November 10, 1994, contains similar language stating that HCFA notified the Department it must budget waiver recipients with a \$50 PNA.

This is to clarify that the Department's policy of budgeting waiver recipients with a \$50 PNA is based on our interpretation of federal regulations and the spousal impoverishment post-eligibility rules, not on a mandate from HCFA. Please note that an Errata Notice will be issued for 95 ADM-19 to clarify the basis for our policy.

This clarification will have no effect on the basic policy set forth in the ADM.
