Guidance: Publicly Available Medicaid Data

<p>What is publicly available Medicaid Data?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) makes de-identified Medicaid data available through the website: <a href="https://www.health.data.ny.gov">https://www.health.data.ny.gov</a>.</li> <li>• MCD Requestors should check to see if the data they are seeking is publicly available on the website before starting an MCD request.</li> </ul>
<p>How can I see publicly available Medicaid Data?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Go to: <a href="https://www.health.data.ny.gov">https://www.health.data.ny.gov</a></li> <li>• Click on the “All Data”</li> <li>• Enter the search term “Medicaid” to see all Medicaid related datasets.</li> <li>• You can also view the full health.data.ny catalog: (<a href="https://health.data.ny.gov/Health/Health-Data-NY-gov-Catalog/3c3b-9i37">https://health.data.ny.gov/Health/Health-Data-NY-gov-Catalog/3c3b-9i37</a>). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The catalog is an interactive dataset providing an alphabetical listing of all data views in the Health Data NY catalog, including description, keywords, custom meta-data notes, column names, and date of last update.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
