**Enhanced Tier 1 CBO involvement includes:**

- **PAM administration-** to address the needs of the uninsured, low utilizing, and non-utilizing Medicaid populations, the Alliance has identified and is partnering with Tier 1 CBOs that work with these populations, pulling from areas such as places of worship, municipal housing sites, food pantries, and community action programs.
- **Community Intake and Referral-** The Alliance is in the process of facilitating collaborations between and among Tier 1 CBOs and Health Homes, Care Management staff, discharge planning staff and facility based social service teams to enhance collaboration and referral for community services. Opportunities such a co-locating these Tier 1 CBOs in provider offices, Emergency Rooms and within urgent care centers to provide immediate I&R services is currently being evaluated.
- **Community Care Management-** the Alliance remains committed to exploring opportunities to engage Tier 1 CBO staff to assist the PPS in strategic population health management via targeted Care Management. At present identification of strategic planning committee.
- **Development of CBO collaborative-** The Alliance believes the Tier 1 CBO provide the foundation of community care coordination. Inherent in the DSRIP program are challenges that small community organizations often face in how to engage into contracts with larger lead organizations, such as PPSs.

Alliance has begun to develop an initiative by which it can assist CBO's with: business development, maximization of core services, identification and access to enhanced technology, staff training and development and promotion of community services all of which will assist CBOs in formulating strategies for short-term needs as well as longer term plans.
