Narrative description of current and future plans for contracting with Tier 1 CBOs.

<p>The strategy for flowing funds to Organizations identified with a TBD, will be defined through the comprehensive three stage strategy noted below.</p> <p>Introduction</p> <p>With the support of DSRIP funds, Montefiore Hudson Valley Collaborative (MHVC) has the unique opportunity to collaboratively design a more integrated delivery system in the Hudson Valley. MHVC is committed to using DSRIP funding to strengthen the communities of care within our network: to ensure that care is coordinated for the whole patient, within both clinical and non-clinical settings, appropriately addressing the social determinants of health.</p> <p>MHVC’s Community Based Organization (CBO) engagement & integration strategy was founded on the cross-PPS Community Needs Assessment, and guided by DSRIP projects. In alignment with guidance from the CBO VBP workgroup our strategy includes three phases: Phase I-Planning & Empowerment, Phase II- Defining Targeted Interventions and Phase III-Supporting Sustainability.</p> <p>Phase I- Planning & Empowerment – “Learn by listening”</p> <p>Listening Tour</p> <p>Early on, to spearhead engagement and learning, MHVC embarked on a “Listening Tour”. Our “Listening Tour” included: coalition meetings in 4 counties, meetings with county government officials and providers in 7 counties, provider meetings, and individual meetings with more than 40 organizations. These meetings were facilitated to obtain input including: needs, linkages, concerns, capacities, and feedback on our communication/engagement to date.</p> <p>Inclusion in Planning</p> <p>CBO partners were included in all phases of planning; development of the MHVC DSRIP application, the Project Implementation Plan submitted to NYS, a defined stakeholder type in MHVC subcommittees and workgroups selection, and played an integral role in process mapping of project specific deliverables.</p> <p>To date, MHVC workgroups have been centralized and focused primarily on the alignment of evidence based guidelines and collaborative development of standardized processes. In the coming months MHVC will be deploying regional transformation teams focused on community and CBO integration. MHVC will renew the focus on Tier 1 CBOs moving forward, relying on CBO input to inform PPS priorities, support strategies for improving population health, and shaping efforts to address health disparities. We recognize their unique role in engaging traditionally hard to reach patients and their expertise in engaging patients in culturally competent ways.</p> <p>Network Assessments</p> <p>In September 2016, MHVC engaged the New York Association of Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services (NYAPRS) a trusted stakeholder in the community, to complete deeper self-assessments for a cohort of 30 CBOs (nine of which were Tier 1); focused on identifying core competencies and best practices as related to the needs of the IDS (training, cultural competency curriculum etc.) and overall readiness for VBP. During these visits CBOs were connected to existing state/regional and local resources, where available, to support and mature organizational understanding of future payment relationships and strategic partnerships. The final NYAPRS report (Q1-2017) will help to define the tangible roles of community- based organizations within our communities of care and shape MHVC’s Level one support for future engagements. MHVC learned that many CBOs are powerfully motivated to participate actively in healthcare transformation and VBP. CBOs know the high value they provide in creating trusted relationships with individuals with the most needs, and they are eager to connect with the healthcare system. Simultaneously MHVC staff facilitated onsite assessments of clinical providers within our contracted Network to begin to understand their current and planned capacity to address social determinants of health, and identify existing CBO relationships (with a focus on Tier1).</p>

<p>Phase II- Defining Targeted Interventions</p> <p>Contracting Approach MHVCs approach to DSRIP contracting to date has been to flow funds to partners that are identified as the primary partner providing of clinical care for our members. E.g. attributed provider. For future rounds MHVC will use data collected by NYAPRs, network assessments and regional engagement to integrate CBO services vital to the network. Identified needs to date include supporting patient education efforts; asthma education, chronic disease management and patient consent to data sharing.</p> <p>Using Data to Drive Improvement One of the key observations reported was that many Tier 1 CBOs do not have the infrastructure required to quantify the impact of their reach within the community, which is essential in establishing a clear value proposition. To address the need for CBOs to use data to quantify their impact on the community, MHVC has provided targeted training on Plan Do Study Act (PDSA) performance improvement strategies and tools. The initial training, facilitated through the Public Health Council, included four Tier 1 CBOs and was very well received by participants. MHVC is committed to spreading this learning across the PPS Network and is currently building stakeholder specific toolsets for broad distribution to network partners. In addition, to “connect the dots” and establish a tangible, data driven value proposition for CBOs, MHVC is piloting a web based referral management system. The system, once implemented, will provide an interface for “closing the loop” between providers and CBOs to establish a connection between these clinical providers and the broader community in which patients live.</p> <p>Improving Referrals to CBOs In our assessments of clinical providers, MHVC learned that many partners did not assess social determinants of health during a clinical visit. Those who did assess, often reported gaps in understanding what services were available and how to refer. To date, MHVC has facilitated many connections through our community engagement work.</p> <p>Moving forward, MHVC’s contracts with clinical providers will incentivize adoption of social determinants of health screening tools and referral processes into workflows. Based on conversation with our Clinical Quality and Finance Subcommittees, MHVC will allocate DSRIP dollars to a program Innovation Fund. This funding will be made available to all MHVC partners through a formal RFP process without regard to stakeholder type or tier. In order to highlight the significance of partnering with Tier 1 CBOs, inclusion of Tier 1 CBO partners, will be a factor in scoring applications submitted.</p> <p>Strengthening Communities of Care As part of our learning and engagement, MHVC has had the opportunity to provide Level 1 support to CBOs to solicit planning grants. MHVC’s early focus on our regional hot spots (Newburgh & Yonkers, NY) led us to engage in a unique opportunity, the LIFT grant, Linking Interventions for total Population Health (LIFT) which is focused on integrating traditional clinical prevention, innovative clinical interventions outside of a clinical setting and total population or community wide interventions. MHVC engaged three Yonkers based providers in the LIFT Grant. Additionally MHVC assisted in writing the plan and producing the list of 14 Hudson Valley CBOs that partnered on the CBO Planning Grant submission. MHVC intends to continue to provide Level one and two support to CBOs to support these types of engagements and to engage them in regional planning around the IDS and establishment of the Medical Villages.</p>

<p>Phase III- Supporting Sustainability</p> <p>MHVC is uniquely positioned to explore models for CBO inclusion in VBP payment arrangements. MHVC is unique in that we are one of only four PPS's deploying the Medical Village project, and are committed to deploying seven Medical Villages across the Hudson Valley. MHVC intends to incentivize partners within each Medical Villages community to flow funds or provide resources to CBOs regionally. In addition to needs identified above, community engagement and education specific to the Medical Village will be essential to their success. CBO partners will play a large role in patient engagement and education; ensuring people understand the new access to care in their communities. Many CBO partners currently receiving Level one resources are also included in Level 2 Medical Village Hubs in anticipation of the maturing relationships.</p> <p>Montefiore's experience building and managing high performing Networks has set the foundation for the Hudson Valley IPA, which is currently in development. The learnings from the Medical Village will inform the role of CBOs within the provider network of the HVIPA.</p> <p>As we move towards full VBP arrangements MHVC/HVIPA will utilize data collected to explore concepts such as CBO patient empanelment, to begin to understand and credit the impact of CBO services on patients' clinical outcomes.</p>
