



Adherence to Antipsychotic Medications for People Living With Schizophrenia







Antidepressant Medication Management - Effective Treatment for Acute Phase








**Diabetes Monitoring for People Living With Diabetes** and Schizophrenia





Follow-up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness within 30 Days







Prescribed ADHD MedicationInitiation Phase







# **Initiation of Alcohol and Other Drug Dependence Treatment**







Comprehensive Diabetes Care HbA1c Testing



The percentage of recipients living with diabetes who received at least one Hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) test within the past year.













Months of Life







Breast Cancer Screening Among Women






