Objectives of VBP Feasibility Workgroup Sub-teams

1. Clarification of the Unit of Analysis

- VBP Contractor -> Practice Group -> Providers
- VBP Contractor may be the focus for payment, while the practice group or provider may be focus for improvement efforts

2. Data Collection Responsibilities

- Current state and new needs for VBP
- Impact or Gaps Data flows, data availability, sources of data

3. Maximize Measure Efficiency

 Leverage internal systems, explore use of Qualified Entities (QEs), develop use cases for plans and contractors, avoid duplication of effort

4. Measure Development Process

 Responsibilities for prioritizing measures, measure specification development, field testing and validation

Behavioral Health Measures Included in TCGP, IPC and HARP Arrangements

- Behavioral Health (BH) measures exist in both the Total Care for General Population (TCGP)/Integrated Primary Care (IPC) Measure Set and the Health and Recovery Plan (HARP) Measure Set.
- The TCGP/IPC Measure set is intended to assess the the physical and behavioral health of the primary care seeking population.
 - The IPC Arrangement has 4 BH Episodes: Depression & Anxiety, Trauma & Stressor, Substance Use Disorder, and Bipolar Disorder
 - Measure Set includes BH measures to support the 4 episodes along with the other physical health measures specified for the general patient population.
- The HARP Measure Set includes BH measures as well as measures that are used to more generally assess physical health specified for the HARP population.
 - Substantial overlap in measures exists between measures in the HARP and TCGP/IPC Measure Sets.
 - In certain cases, there are differences in categorization (Cat 1 vs. Cat 2) and payment classification [Pay for Reporting (P4R) vs. Pay for Performance (P4P)] of overlapping measures.



Measure Development

- Several Behavioral Health and HARP measures require development.
- Steps in the process include:
 - Creation of measure concept and draft technical specifications
 - Review of spec with edits
 - Updated based on edits and finalized
 - Post measure for 30-day public comment period
 - Test Technical Specifications
 - Review Results/Feedback
 - Finalize Specifications
 - Data Validation
- Pilots and the Measure Feasibility Task Force sub-team will assist with development.
