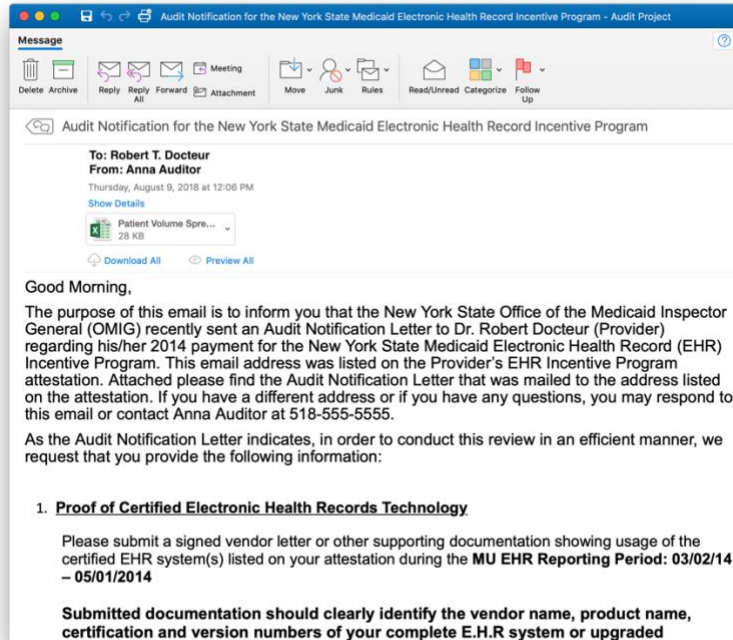


The Five “W’s” of the NY Medicaid EHR Incentive Program Adopt, Implement, or Upgrade (AIU) * Audit Notification Email



* Providers chosen for an audit of their NY Medicaid EHR Incentive Program attestation will receive official notice by way of an Audit Notification Letter sent via U.S. Postal Service Certified mail. The Audit Notification Email is a follow up to the official letter.

WHO receives the Audit Notification Email?

Providers who have been chosen for an audit of their Adopt, Implement, or Upgrade (AIU) attestation will receive this email as a follow up to the official Audit Notification Letter that he or she received by certified mail.

WHAT is the purpose of the email?

To inform the provider that OMIG recently sent an Audit Notification Letter and note the documentation the provider is required to submit in order to support his or her attestation for the NY Medicaid EHR Incentive Program.

WHERE can I go for more information or if I need help?

The email will provide links to several helpful resources and contact information for the assigned auditor.

WHEN do I need to submit documentation?

Both the Audit Notification Email and Audit Notification Letter will note the due date for the documentation.

WHY is it important to send documentation?

Providers who do not furnish the requested information may fail the audit and may have to repay the NY Medicaid EHR incentive payment that they previously received.
