



DEADLINE REMINDER: Registration of Intent for Meaningful Use Public Health Reporting Measures

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Eligible Professionals (EPs) and Eligible Hospitals (EHs) with a full calendar year EHR Reporting Period intending to submit data to registries sponsored by the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) and/or New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (NYC DOHMH) for Payment Year 2016 **must submit a registration of intent by April 14**, **2016.**

Please note, EPs and EHs demonstrating Meaningful Use for the first time in 2016 will have a 90-day EHR Reporting Period and must register intent within 60 days of the start of their EHR Reporting Period.

REMINDER: EPs and EHs must register intent for each Public Health Reporting Measure they intend to use to meet Meaningful Use. A new enhanced Meaningful Use Registration for Public Health (MURPH) System has been released to support registration of intent to submit data to NSYDOH or NYC DOHMH sponsored registries. If you submitted a registration of intent in the MURPH System in a previous year, we strongly encourage you to complete a new registration to take advantage of the enhanced features.

MURPH Application Tips:

- If your organization needs to register intent for 150 or more EPs, please call our MU Public Health Objective Support Team at 1-877-646-5410 Option 3 prior to submitting a registration
- Complete a single registration for your organization and add all locations and EPs registering intent to submit data
 - Only add locations where at least one EP practices
 - o Only add EPs who intend to submit data to at least one NYSDOH or NYC DOHMH registry
- Click "Save" or "Submit" prior to exiting the MURPH application to prevent the loss of data
