Meaningful Use Registration for Public Health (MURPH) System Updated and Population Health Specialized Registry Added for NYC EPs

IMPORTANT NOTICE: The Meaningful Use Registration for Public Health (MURPH) System has been updated to further enhance the system and add Population Health Reporting (Specialized Registry).

The Population Health Registry is a Specialized Registry for Eligible Professionals (EPs) who practice inside the five boroughs of NYC. Review the <u>Population Health Registry webpage</u> for more information.

If you are a NYC EP and intend to submit data to the Population Health Registry, then we strongly encourage you to update your registration as soon as possible.

REMINDER:

Eligible Hospitals (EHs) and Eligible Professionals (EPs) demonstrating Meaningful Use for the first time in 2016 will have a 90 day EHR Reporting Period and must register intent for each Public Health Meaningful Use Reporting Measure they intend to meet before or within 60 days of the start of their EHR Reporting Period.
