## **NEW APPLICATION**

including care in a hospital that is equivalent to nursing home care. Supplement A must be signed and dated by the applicant and/or his/her representative and if appropriate, the applicant's spouse. An S/CC or ADC-Related applicant who requires temporary nursing home care is not required to complete Supplement A. However, if such S/CC or ADC-Related applicant has a community spouse and such spouse is in a medical institution and/or nursing facility and is likely to remain in the facility for at least 30 consecutive days, Supplement A must be completed.

**NOTE**: Effective April 1, 2010, an LDSS can no longer require that an application interview take place.

## OTHER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS APPLICATION, CERTIFICATION AND RENEWAL

## **NEW APPLICATION**

**Interpretation:** An application may be made by the applicant, his/her authorized representative or, when the applicant is incompetent or incapacitated,

by someone acting responsibly for him/her. The applicant or someone acting responsibly on the applicant's behalf must sign the application in ink. When both a husband and wife are applying, both spouses are required to sign the "State-prescribed form". If only one spouse is applying, the non-applying spouse cannot be required to sign the application even though information concerning his/her financial circumstances is necessary to determine eligibility for the applying spouse.
