## ADC-RELATED BUDGETING

**Policy:** The following persons who apply for Medicaid are entitled to ADC-related budgeting, if they are ineligible under LIF budgeting:

- Families with a dependent child under age 21;
- Persons under age 21;
- Pregnant women, and
- FNP parents.

Interpretation: There are certain forms of income that are not considered in the calculation of gross monthly income for budgeting purposes.

The following topics are discussed in detail for ADC-related budgeting:

- \$90 work expense disregard;
- \$30 and 1/3;
- Child care/incapacitated adult care cost; and
- Health insurance premiums.

These disregards are discussed in the order that they are subtracted from the A/R's income. In addition, **INCOME** <u>ADC-</u><u>RELATED</u> <u>DISREGARDS</u> describes the \$100 support payment disregard that is deducted from support income (child support and alimony) only before determining the countable gross income of the A/R.
