## CATEGORICAL FACTORS

## FAMILY PLANNING BENEFIT PROGRAM (FPBP)

Description: The FPBP provides Medicaid reimbursement for family planning

services on a fee-for-service basis. Federal financial participation for such services is 90 percent in accordance with Section 1903(a)(5) of the Social Security Act. There is no local cost for

services provided under the FPBP.

Policy: The FPBP provides Medicaid coverage for family planning services

only to men and women of childbearing age with incomes at or below 200% of the federal poverty level (FPL). FPBP services are available only to persons who are not otherwise eligible for Medicaid or Family Health Plus, or who have indicated in writing

that they want to apply for the FPBP only.

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Interpretation: Males and females of child bearing age whose income is at or

below 200% of the FPL, may be eligible for the FPBP when they:

are New York State residents; and

are citizens or otherwise eligible immigrants with satisfactory

immigration status; and are either:

not otherwise eligible for Medicaid or Family Health Plus (FHPlus) or have indicated in writing that they want to apply for the FPBP

only; or

under age 21 and living with their parents and apply for family planning services and do not have parental financial information. Eligibility is determined by comparing only the income of the

person under 21 to 200% of FPL.

There is no resource test for the FPBP.

The FPBP does not cover abortions.
