Posting eWIC benefits, foods, baby formula, or breast pumps for sale in newspapers *OR* on the Internet is **FRAUD**. This includes:

- Craig's List
- Facebook
- Instagram
  - Twitter
  - eBay
- Any other social media outlet

Giving away eWIC benefits, foods, baby formula, or breast pumps OR selling them for cash is **FRAUD**.



If you suspect that someone may be committing **FRAUD**, please contact the Bureau of Special Investigations (BSI). You may report your concerns anonymously.




## DID YOU KNOW? (STOP) FRAUD

Enrollment in WIC at more than ONE local agency is FRAUD.

Reporting false income, household size OR pregnancy to become eligible to participate in WIC is FRAUD.





Buying or selling eWIC benefits, foods, baby formula, or breast pumps *OR* allowing someone else to do so is FRAUD. Giving your eWIC card & PIN to a vendor is FRAUD.



YOU MAY BE:

- **DISQUALIFIED** from the WIC Program.
- Required to **REPAY IN CASH** the value of foods, baby formula or breast pump issued to you.

• **PROSECUTED** under State and Federal laws.
