HIV TESTING IN LOCAL HEALTH UNIT STD CLINICS

HIV testing at local health unit STD clinics continued to expand in 1993. All major STD clinics in New York State outside of New York City offer full counseling, testing and referral services to patients. A majority of smaller county clinics also offer the range of services to the extent that some 85-90 percent of all STD clinic patients in New York State excluding New York City can be tested at an STD clinic site.

In 1993, more than 19,300 clinic patients were tested for HIV, fully 53 percent of those attending STD clinics. Of those tested, 246 (1.1%) were positive for HIV. More people are tested for HIV in STD clinics than in any other type of testing site in New York State outside of New York City.
