

Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department $(ED)^{\dagger}$ Visits

Bronx County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related death in Bronx County.
- Annually, 48 Bronx County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 24 Pedestrians
 - 13 Unspecified Persons
 - 6 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Occupants
 - * Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the fourth leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Bronx County.
- •Annually, 864 Bronx County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 370 Pedestrians
 - 291 Occupants
 - 110 Motorcyclists
 - 50 Bicyclists
 - 35 Unspecified Persons



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the fourth leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Bronx County.
- Annually, 10,501 Bronx County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 7,176 Occupants
 - 1,663 Pedestrians
 - 865 Unspecified Persons
 - 307 Motorcyclists
 - 324 Bicyclists
