

## Leading Causes of All Injury

# Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)<sup>†</sup> Visits Broome County Residents, 2012-2014




#### **Deaths**

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related death in Broome County.
- Annually, 14 Broome County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 6 Unspecified Persons
  - 3 Occupants
  - 2 Pedestrians
  - 2 Motorcyclists
  - \* Bicyclists



### Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Broome County.
- Annually, 123 Broome County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 77 Occupants
  - 23 Motorcyclists
  - 16 Pedestrians
  - 5 Unspecified Persons
  - 3 Bicyclists



### **Emergency Department (ED)**<sup>†</sup> Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Broome County.
- •Annually, 1,134 Broome County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
  - 853 Occupants
  - 109 Unspecified Persons
  - 67 Pedestrians
  - 65 Motorcyclists
  - 28 Bicyclists
