

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Clinton County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related death in Clinton County.
- •Annually, 5 Clinton County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 2 Occupants
 - 2 Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Pedestrians
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Clinton County.
- •Annually, 24 Clinton County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 15 Occupants
 - 6 Motorcyclists
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Clinton County.
- Annually, 494 Clinton County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 384 Occupants
 - 60 Unspecified Persons
 - 28 Motorcyclists
 - 16 Pedestrians
 - 3 Bicyclists
