

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Columbia County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Columbia County.
- Annually, 7 Columbia County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3 Occupants
 - 2 Unspecified Persons
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Columbia County.
- Annually, 46 Columbia County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 34 Occupants
 - 5 Motorcyclists
 - 4 Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Columbia County.
- Annually, 339 Columbia County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 292 Occupants
 - 13 Motorcyclists
 - 9 Pedestrians
 - 6 Unspecified Persons
 - 6 Bicyclists
