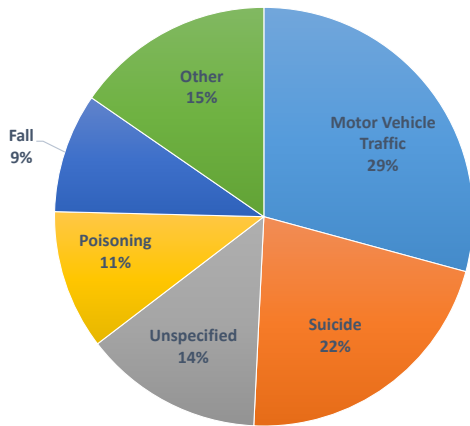
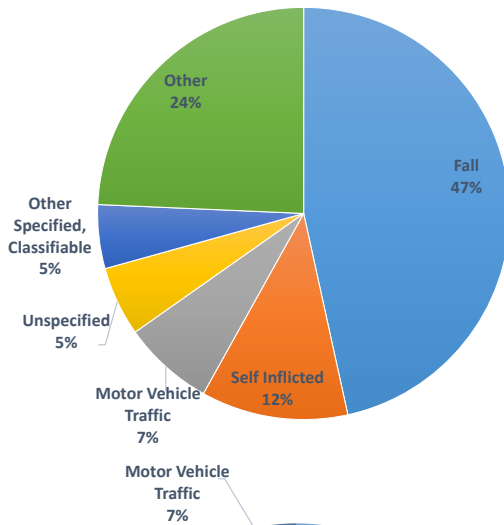

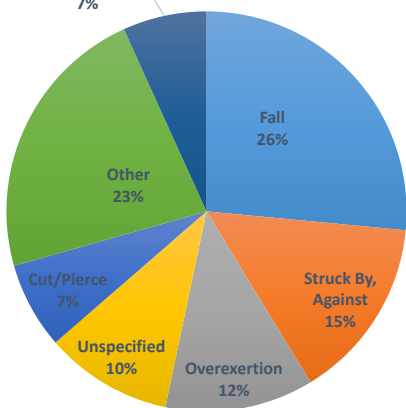
### Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause of injury related death in Cortland County.
- Annually, 6 Cortland County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 3 Unspecified Persons
  - \* Occupants
  - \* Pedestrians
  - \* Motorcyclists
  - 0 Bicyclists



### Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Cortland County.
- Annually, 27 Cortland County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 14 Occupants
  - 6 Motorcyclists
  - 4 Pedestrians
  - \* Unspecified Persons
  - \* Bicyclists



### Emergency Department (ED)<sup>†</sup> Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Cortland County.
- Annually, 149 Cortland County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
  - 123 Occupants
  - 9 Unspecified Persons
  - 8 Motorcyclists
  - 6 Pedestrians
  - 3 Bicyclists
