


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Dutchess County Residents, 2012-2014





Hospitalizations

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Dutchess County.
- •Annually, 293 Dutchess County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 202 Occupants
 - 41 Motorcyclists
 - 31 Pedestrians
 - 11 Bicyclists
 - 8 Unspecified Persons



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Dutchess County.
- •Annually, 2,507 Dutchess County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 2,144 Occupants
 - 163 Unspecified Persons
 - 86 Pedestrians
 - 80 Motorcyclists
 - 25 Bicyclists

The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitted into the hospital
