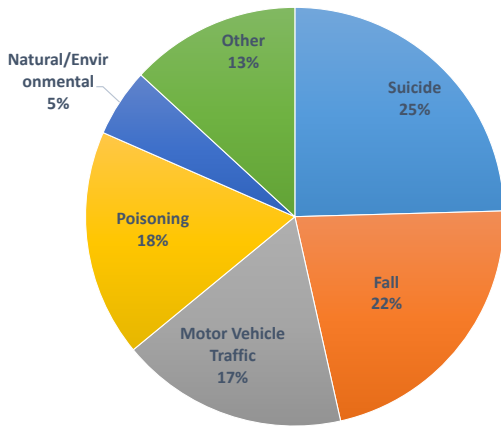
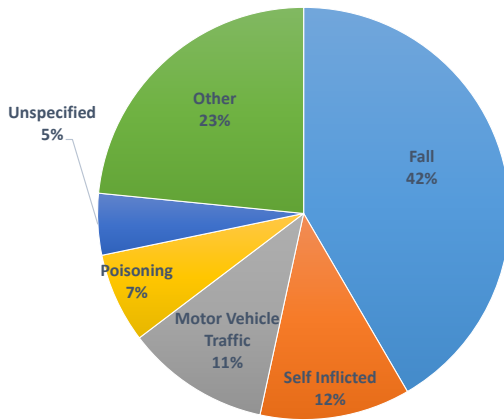


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Madison County Residents, 2012-2014



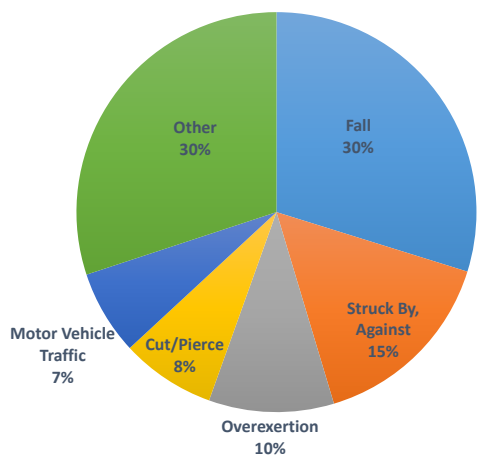
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related death in Madison County.
- Annually, 7 Madison County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 4 Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Madison County.
- Annually, 44 Madison County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 31 Occupants
 - 7 Motorcyclists
 - 2 Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Madison County.
- Annually, 331 Madison County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 285 Occupants
 - 15 Unspecified Persons
 - 13 Motorcyclists
 - 9 Pedestrians
 - 7 Bicyclists
