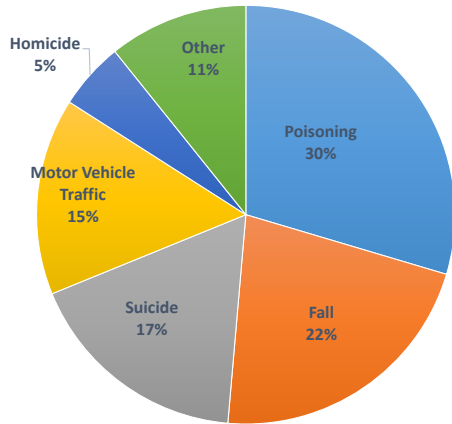
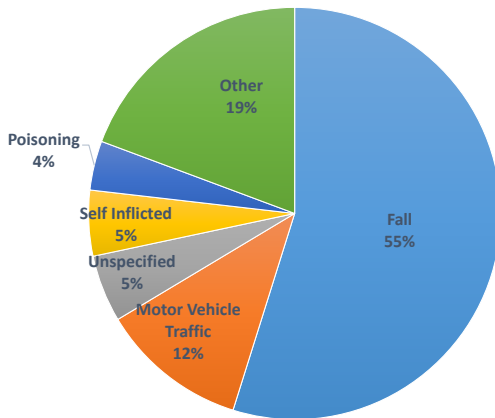


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Nassau County Residents, 2012-2014



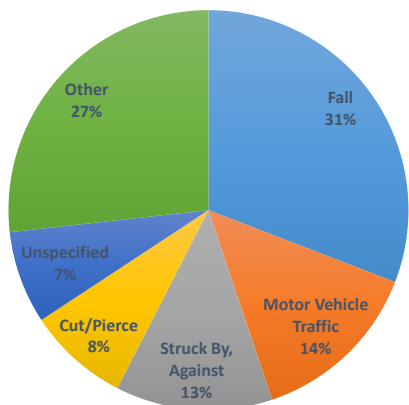
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related death in Nassau County.
- Annually, 81 Nassau County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 32 Pedestrians
 - 29 Occupants
 - 10 Unspecified Persons
 - 7 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Nassau County.
- Annually, 1415 Nassau County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 858 Occupants
 - 294 Pedestrians
 - 73 Unspecified Persons
 - 118 Motorcyclists
 - 64 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Nassau County.
- Annually, 12,340 Nassau County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 10,458 Occupants
 - 717 Pedestrians
 - 707 Unspecified Persons
 - 233 Motorcyclists
 - 182 Bicyclists
