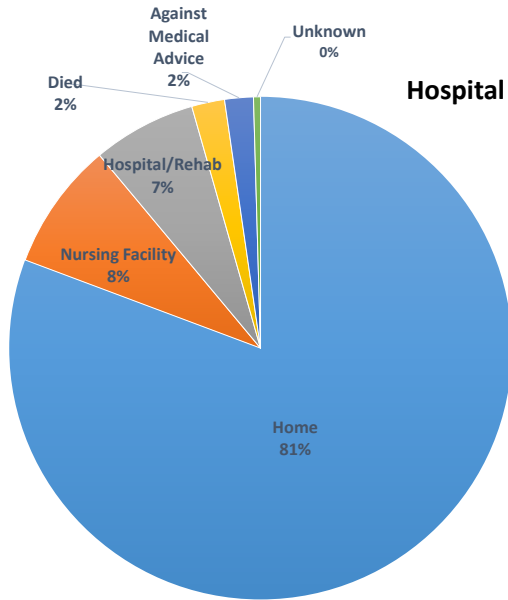


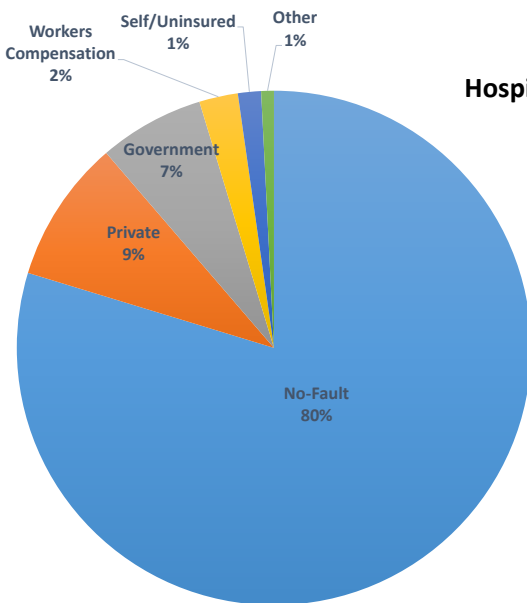
**Motor Vehicle Traffic Injury
Hospital Discharge Disposition and Charges
Nassau County Residents, 2012-2014**



Hospital Discharge Disposition

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of 1337 hospitalizations

- 1,079 Were discharged to their home
- 110 Were discharged to a skilled nursing facility
- 89 Were discharged to another hospital or rehabilitation center
- 74 Left against medical advice
- 28 Died



Hospitalization Charges

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of \$77.6 Million in hospitalization charges. Based on the expected principle payer source, there were:

- \$61.8 Million charged to no-fault insurance
- \$5.1 Million charged to public funds
- \$7.0 Million charged to private insurance programs
- \$1.9 Million charged to workers compensation
- \$1.1 Million charged to private pay and uninsured individuals
