

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Richmond County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the fourth leading cause of injury related death in Richmond County.
- Annually, 17 Richmond County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 9 Pedestrians
 - 3 Occupants
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - 3 Motorcyclists
 - * Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Richmond County.
- Annually, 554 Richmond County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 309 Occupants
 - 157 Pedestrians
 - 47 Motorcyclists
 - 19 Unspecified Persons
 - 16 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Richmond County.
- Annually, 4,063 Richmond County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3,457 Occupants
 - 324 Pedestrians
 - 128 Unspecified Persons
 - 88 Motorcyclists
 - 36 Bicyclists
