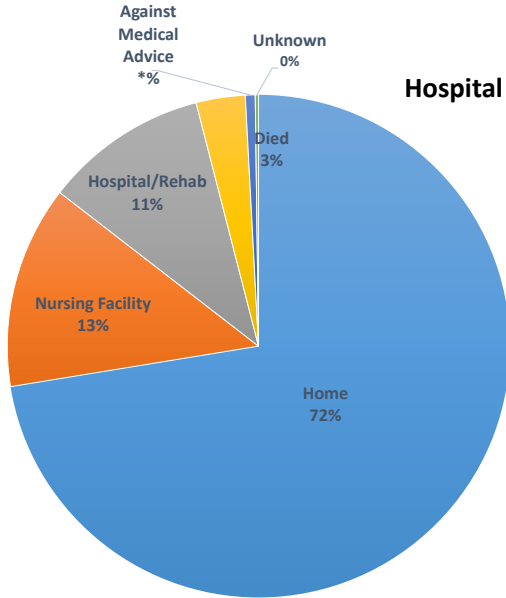


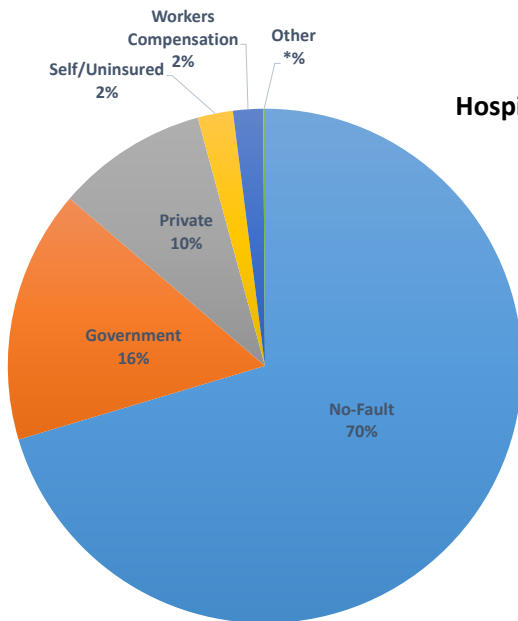
**Motor Vehicle Traffic Injury
Hospital Discharge Disposition and Charges
Rockland County Residents, 2012-2014**



Hospital Discharge Disposition

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of 158 hospitalizations

- 115 Were discharged to their home
- 21 Were discharged to a skilled nursing facility
- 17 Were discharged to another hospital or rehabilitation center
- 5 Died
- * Left against medical advice



Hospitalization Charges

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of \$13.1 Million in hospitalization charges. Based on the expected principle payer source, there were:

- \$9.2 Million charged to no-fault insurance
- \$2.1 Million charged to public funds
- \$1.2 Million charged to private insurance programs
- \$289.6 Thousand charged to private pay and uninsured individuals
- \$247.5 Thousand charged to workers compensation
