

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Schenectady County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related death in Schenectady County.
- Annually, 8 Schenectady County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 2 Occupants
 - 2 Pedestrians
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Schenectady County.
- Annually, 90 Schenectady County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 53 Occupants
 - 19 Motorcyclists
 - 15 Pedestrians
 - 3 Bicyclists
 - * Unspecified Persons



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Schenectady County.
- Annually, 1,320 Schenectady County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 1,054 Occupants
 - 90 Pedestrians
 - 70 Unspecified Persons
 - 60 Motorcyclists
 - 35 Bicyclists
