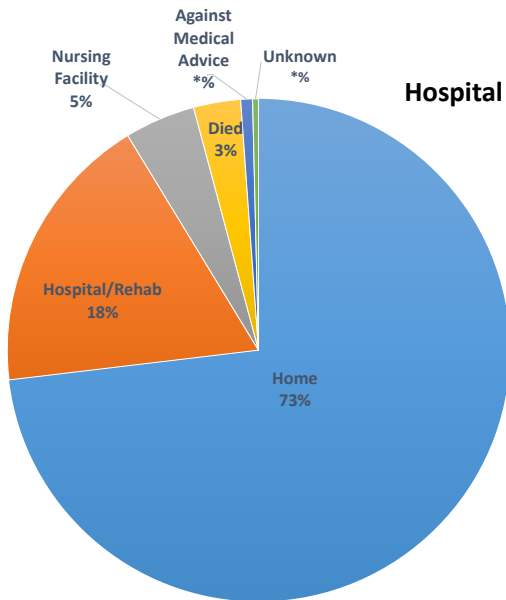


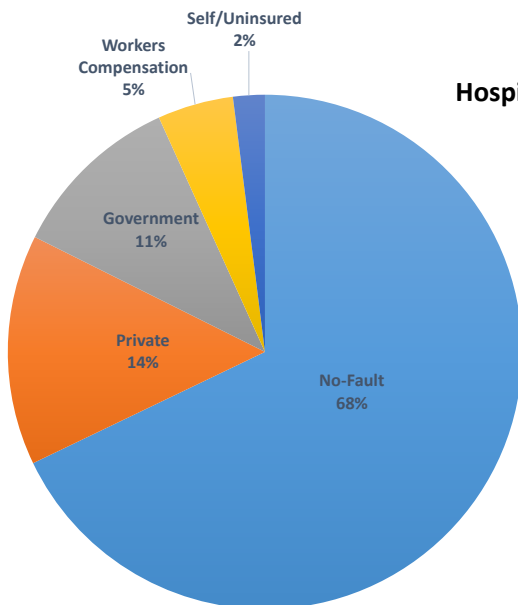
Motor Vehicle Traffic Injury  
Hospital Discharge Disposition and Charges  
Schenectady County Residents, 2012-2014



**Hospital Discharge Disposition**

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of 88 hospitalizations

- 64 Were discharged to their home
- 16 Were discharged to another hospital or rehabilitation center
- 4 Were discharged to a skilled nursing facility
- 3 Died
- \* Left against medical advice



**Hospitalization Charges**

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of \$5.2 Million in hospitalization charges. Based on the expected principle payer source, there were:

- \$3.5 Million charged to no-fault insurance
- \$753.0 Thousand charged to private insurance programs
- \$564.8 Thousand charged to public funds
- \$247.8 Thousand charged to workers compensation
- \$103.7 Thousand charged to private pay and uninsured individuals
