

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Suffolk County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related death in Suffolk County.
- Annually, 129 Suffolk County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 16 Occupants
 - 35 Pedestrians
 - 57 Unspecified Persons
 - 18 Motorcyclists
 - 4 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Suffolk County.
- Annually, 1,487 Suffolk County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 977 Occupants
 - 193 Pedestrians
 - 172 Motorcyclists
 - 67 Unspecified Persons
 - 66 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Suffolk County.
- Annually, 17,590 Suffolk County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 15,220 Occupants
 - 1,006 Unspecified Persons
 - 650 Pedestrians
 - 387 Motorcyclists
 - 269 Bicyclists
