



## Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Tompkins County.
- •Annually, 34 Tompkins County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 24 Occupants
  - 3 Pedestrians
  - 3 Unspecified Persons
  - 3 Motorcyclists
  - \* Bicyclists



## **Emergency Department (ED)<sup>†</sup> Visits**

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Tompkins County.
- •Annually, 426 Tompkins County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
  - 331 Occupants
  - 28 Unspecified Persons
  - 27 Pedestrians
  - 16 Motorcyclists
  - 6 Bicyclists
