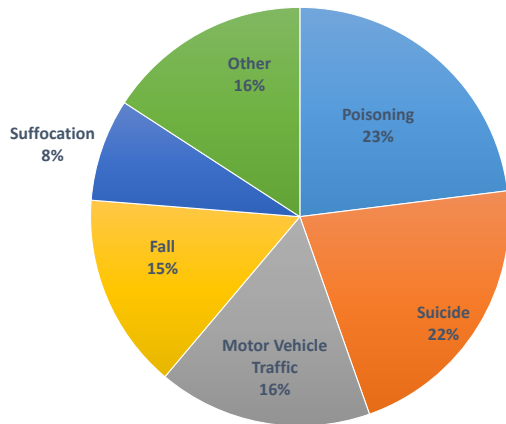
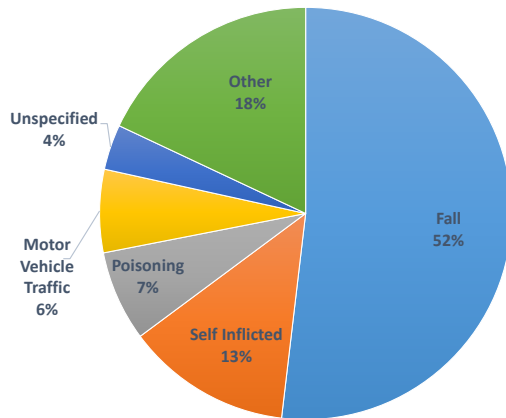


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Tompkins County Residents, 2012-2014



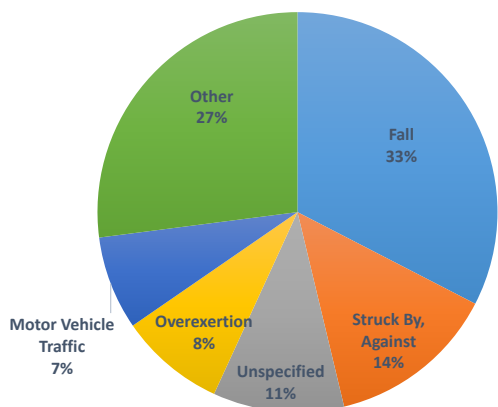
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related death in Tompkins County.
- Annually, 8 Tompkins County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 6 Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Tompkins County.
- Annually, 34 Tompkins County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 24 Occupants
 - 3 Pedestrians
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - 3 Motorcyclists
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Tompkins County.
- Annually, 426 Tompkins County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 331 Occupants
 - 28 Unspecified Persons
 - 27 Pedestrians
 - 16 Motorcyclists
 - 6 Bicyclists
