

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Ulster County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Ulster County.
- Annually, 17 Ulster County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 7 Occupants
 - 6 Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Bicyclists
 - * Pedestrians



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Ulster County.
- Annually, 162 Ulster County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 115 Occupants
 - 22 Motorcyclists
 - 13 Pedestrians
 - 6 Unspecified Persons
 - 4 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Ulster County.
- Annually, 1,422 Ulster County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 1,202 Occupants
 - 81 Unspecified Persons
 - 52 Motorcyclists
 - 50 Pedestrians
 - 29 Bicyclists
