

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Westchester County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related death in Westchester County.
- Annually, 37 Westchester County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 14 Occupants
 - 10 Unspecified Persons
 - 9 Pedestrians
 - 4 Motorcyclists
 - * Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Westchester County.
- Annually, 534 Westchester County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 292 Occupants
 - 125 Pedestrians
 - 65 Motorcyclists
 - 30 Unspecified Persons
 - 15 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Westchester County.
- Annually, 6,420 Westchester County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 5,192 Occupants
 - 564 Pedestrians
 - 349 Unspecified Persons
 - 171 Motorcyclists
 - 77 Bicyclists
