

New York State - Weekly JYNNEOS Vaccination Demographic Report

Vaccinations reported to the New York State Immunization Information System (NYSIIS), as of 12/18/22

Under the [7/29/22 Executive Order](#), providers were required to report all JYNNEOS vaccinations administered into NYSIIS. With the expiration of that order vaccination reporting is now voluntary, and records will not reflect all JYNNEOS vaccines administered. The numbers presented below reflect all administered first doses reported. Totals do not include vaccines administered in New York City.

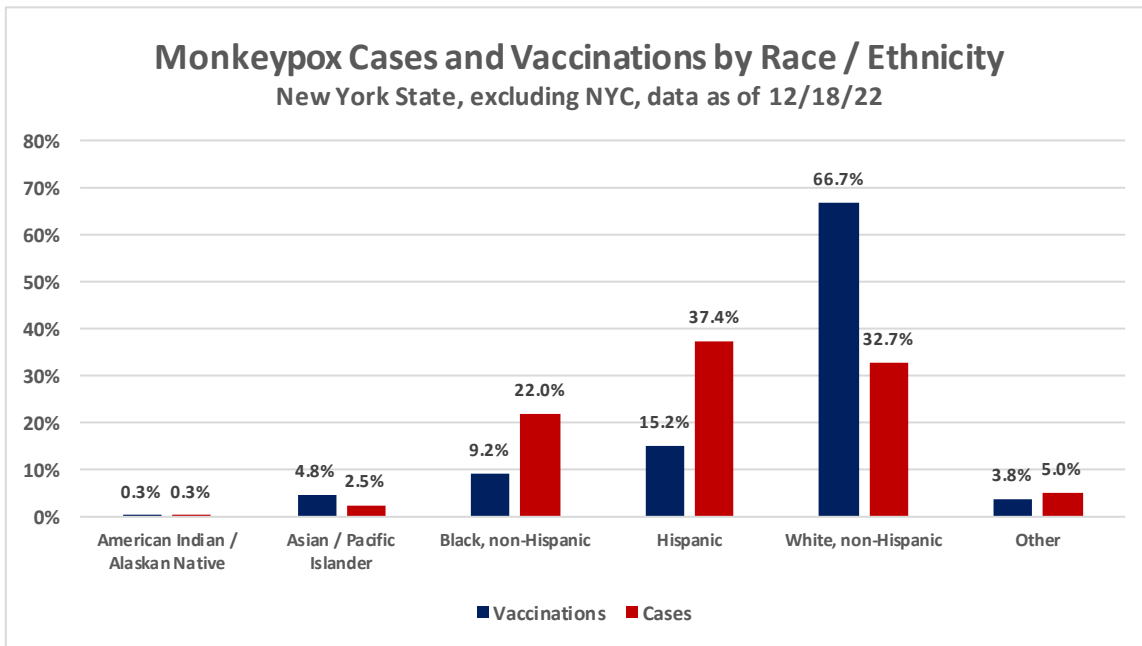
