- Three phases: 2014 to 2020
 - First phase: data analysis and select measure (completed April 1, 2015)
 - Second phase: plan to align infrastructure and evaluate (completed April 1, 2016)
 - Third phase: implementation (report on progress each year)
 - Cohort 1 (February 2018 – Fall 2018)
 - Cohort 2 (Fall 2018 – Fall 2019)
 - **Training (September 2019 – September 2020)**

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State Systemic Improvement Plan

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- Three phases: 2014 to 2020
 - First phase: data analysis and select measure (completed April 1, 2015)
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 - Third phase: implementation (report on progress each year)
 - Cohort 1 (February 2018 – Fall 2018)

 - **Current report will be submitted to the US Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) on April 1, 2021**
- **Continuation of Phase Three: SSIP 2020 - 2021**



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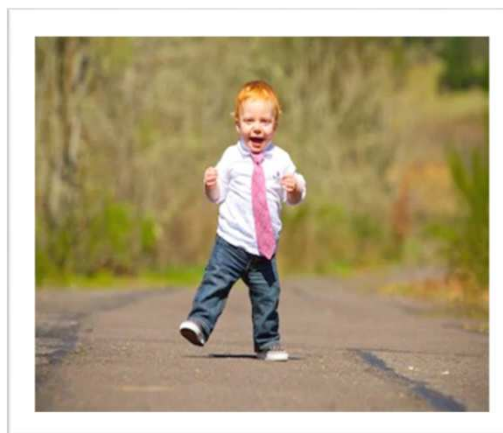
