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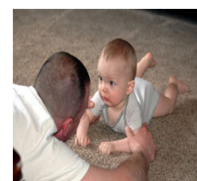
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Promoting Positive Parenting – Triple P

Awarded funding to nine (9) awards to OASAS Funded prevention providers and state community coalitions that partnered with:

- OASAS Certified and State Operated Treatment Programs
- Child Welfare Agencies
- Buffalo Urban League
- Kinship Programs



Triple P Level 3 – Group Discussion for 0-12

- Two-hour small group sessions, targeting a specific problem behavior or issue. Each discussion group can be taken as a stand-alone session or as part of a series. Four (4) Sessions
- Approximately four individual consultations lasting between 15 and 30 minutes
- Monthly Learning Collaborative



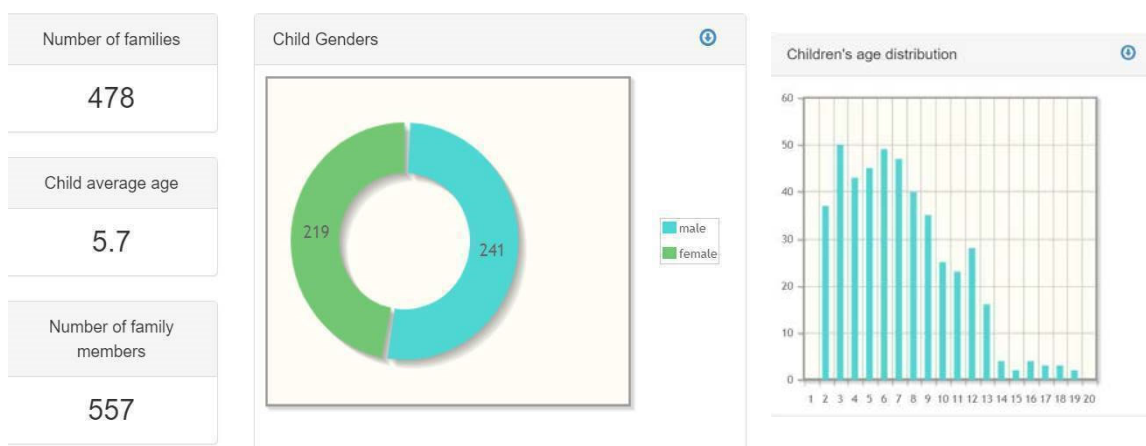
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Participant Data

Majority of participants were from households that have an annual income of \$30,000 or less



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Parenting Experience Survey



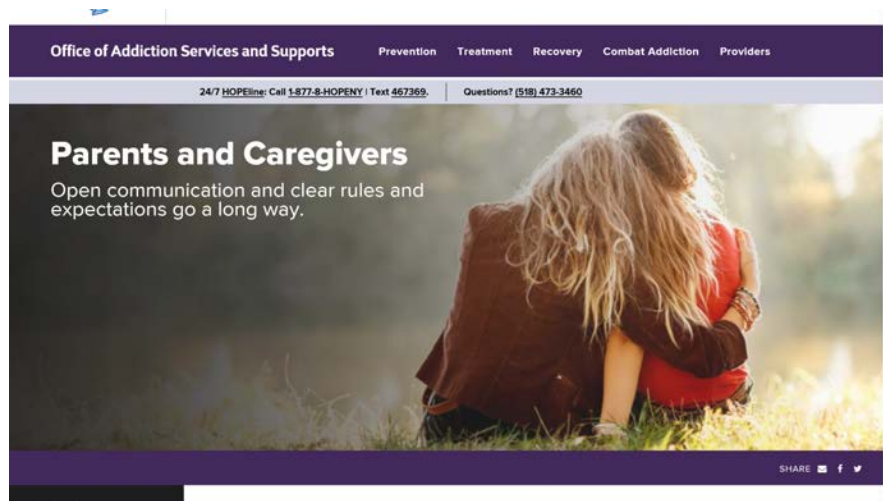
- Participants reported reduction of child behavioral problems and emotional maladjustment from pre to post.
- Parents reported an increase in feeling supported and having positive parenting experiences from pre to post.

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Brief Intervention Services

- *Designed for individuals who are already exhibiting symptoms and behaviors of substance misuse or problem gambling, but do not meet the criteria for a diagnosis of substance use disorders, or a gambling disorder. The aim is to not only to reduce levels of substance misuse and/or problem gambling but decrease the length of time the symptoms or behaviors continue and/or reduce the need to refer for treatment services.*
- **Teen Intervene** - Evidenced-based program (EBP) for youth 12 - 19; integrates stages of change theory, motivational enhancement, and cognitive behavioral therapy
- **SBIRT** - Screening & Brief Intervention Referral to Treatment
- **BASICS** - Brief Alcohol Screening and Intervention for College
- **GBIRT** - Gambling Brief Intervention Referral to Treatment

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Problem Gambling Resource Centers

- Regional Hub for Problem Gambling focusing on collaboration in communities and increasing awareness
- Community needs assessments related to gambling acceptability, laws, community norms, access, etc. to help inform the best way to develop specific problem gambling prevention in communities
- Coordination with regional gambling facilities addressing identification of problem gambling, responsible gambling messaging and Self Exclusion
- Receive warm transfers via the HOPEline

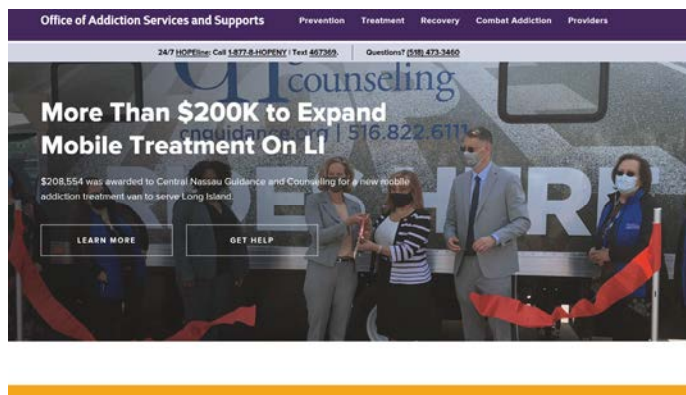

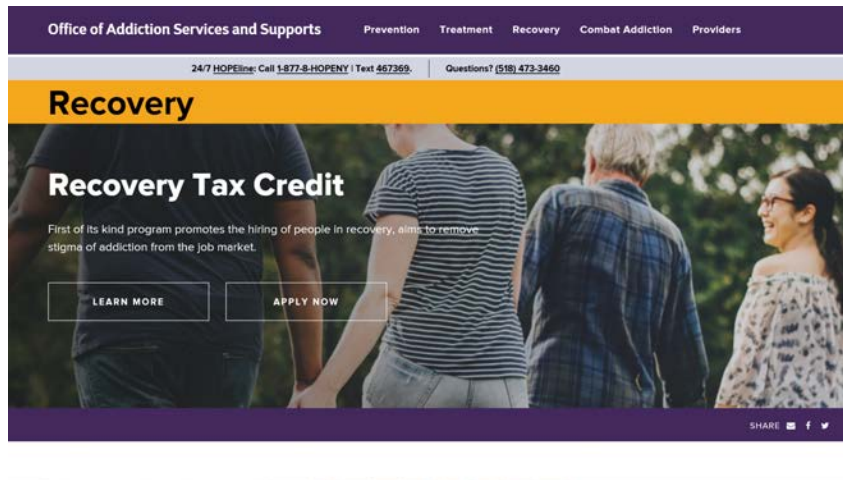

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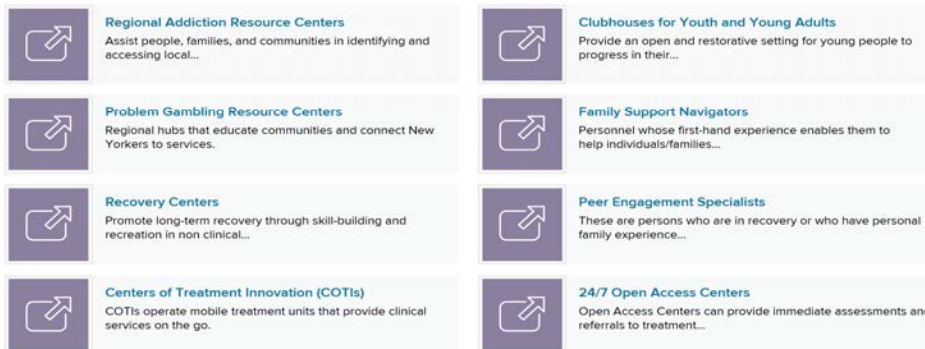
