Health Clinic Administrator:

Pursuant to our tribal consultation policy, we are writing to inform you about a proposed Child Health Plus State Plan Amendment, NY-25-0041-CHIP, which proposes to use CHIP funds for other child health assistance as authorized under § 2105(a)(2) of the Act, to support the extension of the postpartum period from the previous 60-day period to a full 12-month period which has been in place since March 2023. This Health Service Initiative (HSI) will provide services to birthing parents of targeted low-income children throughout the State covered from conception through the 12-month of postpartum. The prenatal and postpartum care provided to this CHIP HSI population is identical to the care provided to the state's Medicaid population. The effective date is April 1, 2024.
